ARTUR DUTKIEWICZ TRIO is one of the best Polish jazz bands / Jazz Forum Magazine Poll 2015/
Their style is unique and recognizable.

Artur Dutkiewicz, called the "ambassador of Polish jazz" /Jazz Forum Magazine 2012/, is one of the most active abroad Polish jazz musicians. During his music career he appeared in more than 60 countries around the world from the USA through Europe, Africa, China to Australia.

Michał Barański and Łukasz Żyta are the best rhythm section in Polish jazz. They play regularly with Bennie Maupin at his concerts in Europe. They were also performing with Brad Terry, Nigel Kennedy, Tomasz Stanko, Dan Tepfer, Dayna Stephens, Atma Anur, Zbigniew Namysłowski, Michał Urbaniak.

Arthur Dutkiewicz Trio were touring all over the world, recently in Australia, New Zealand, Indonesia, Canada, Russia, Macedonia, Turkey, Azerbaijan and Poland.

The Trio performs leader's compositions from last albums TRAVELLER and PRANA, where large emotional load of expressive themes, elements of Polish folk and world music combined with meditative phrases can be found.

The whole material is strongly embedded in the roots of jazz improvisation.

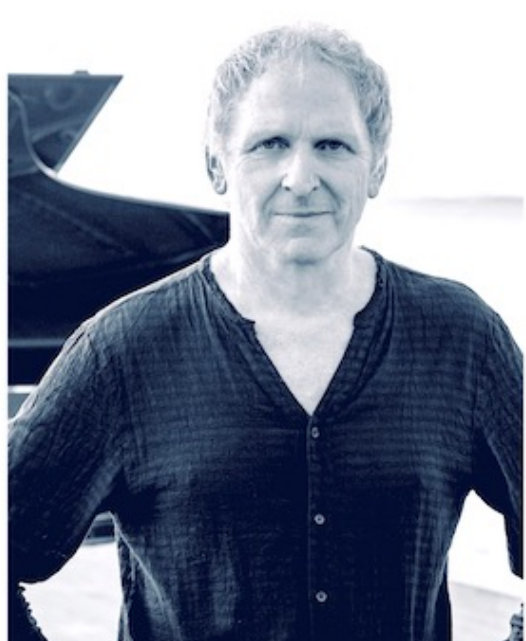

ARTUR DUTKIEWICZ

One of the leading Polish jazz musicians, pianist, composer. Born in Pinczów, Poland in 1958.

He graduated from The Academy of Music in Katowice, Poland and received diploma with distinction.

Dutkiewicz was a finalist of the Thelonious Monk Competition in Washington, USA.

He was the first Polish musician who played a solo recital at MIDEM in Cannes.

He is a leader of the ARTUR DUTKIEWICZ TRIO playing modern jazz and also he plays SOLO RECITALS.

His last albums: "Mazurki"/solo/, „Prana”, „Traveller"/trio/ have been superbly received by audiences and critics alike.

Dutkiewicz has taken part in dozens renowned jazz and music festivals around the world such as: Northsea

Jazz Festival – Hague, Jazz Jamboree – Warsaw, Campnagel Theater – Hamburg, Festival Kleiner Bunchen – Bern, Jazz Ost West – Nuremberg, MIDEM – Cannes, Music Oggi – Milan, Festival D`Europe Centrale – Paris, Europe XXL – Vienna, Sziget Festival – Budapest, Jazz Plaza Festival – Havana, Tel Aviv Jazz Festival, Glasgow Jazz Festival, Duesseldorf Jazz Rally, World Culture Festival - Berlin, Notturmi in Palestro Festival - Milan, BJ Ninegates Jazz Festival – Beijing, Kontu Festival – Helsinki, Melbourne Int. Jazz Festival, Izmir European Jazz Fest.

He took many concert tours; in Asia /China, Singapore, Vietnam, Thailand, India/, Australia and New Zealand /Adelaide-Brighton Concert Hall, Perth Int. Jazz Festival, Melbourne Int. Jazz Festival, Brisbane Int. Jazz Fest., Sydney/Foundry 616, Auckland, Waiheke Island, Wellington, Tauranga, Hamilton/, Canada /Vancouver, Edmonton, Calgary, Kelowna/, South America /Chile, Peru, Brasil/, Balkans /Slovenia, Bosnia, Macedonia, Montenegro, Albania/, and whole Europe.

In 2011 Arthur Dutkiewicz performed at the Olympic Stadium in Berlin during the World Culture Festival arranging and playing a piece for 30 pianos with pianists from around the world. The concert gathered 35 thousand of audience.

- a minimum of one hour for soundcheck
